



Document to help you run the training.

The training is organised in several modules. Depending on the time you have available and the autonomy of your audience, it's up to you to decide how many modules you would like to present, and how: as a whole group, in small groups followed by a discussion, or on your own.

You will find modules on different themes. It's advisable to do them in the order of publication on the site, with the exception of the ecology module. This module is very important and comprehensive. It's best to show one document a day, to raise awareness of this theme without tiring young people.

It's also advisable not to show more than one document per half-day, or if necessary to intersperse them with moments of exchange or workshops proposed in the "Orientation workshops" tab.

To help you get organised, a sample schedule is provided at the end of this document.

In module 1, the slides 8 and 9 show a certain number of professions in agriculture. We invite you to let young people click on them and do further research.

Please note that the questions asked in these modules are designed to get young people thinking, and that you are not expected to master the subject. Explanatory videos provide at least partial answers.

You can call on the services of agricultural experts (farmers, associations, chambers of agriculture) to help you during your session, either face-to-face or by videoconference. Don't hesitate to support this training with visits.

Please let us know if you have any questions that have not been answered by the documents provided, or if you have any comments that would enable us to better adapt the content to your needs.

We hope you have a wonderful time, based on sharing, discovery and kindness.
