Identify in the job offer:

- -Working conditions: outdoors or indoors, staggered hours, night or weekend work, \dots
 - -Salaries offered
 - -Skills and know-how required:
- -skills: autonomy around animals, use of farm machinery, ability to work in a team or independently, ability to listen and follow instructions, ...
- -interpersonal skills: punctuality, politeness, cleanliness (on the job, in the work environment and in the break room).
